The Oversight Committee has called for a Special Meeting of Members for TODAY, May 18, after worship, to vote on the following recommendation:

The Oversight Committee be given the following specific authority in accordance with the Bylaws of Old South Congregational Church United Church of Christ, Hallowell, Maine (Article VIII.9.b.9):

- 1. To create a new listing agreement with our realtor to:
- a) List the sanctuary building and the parish house together as a package for a price to be recommended by our realtor; and
- b) Continue to list the sanctuary building as a separate option at a price recommended by our realtor.
- 2. To authorize the Oversight Committee to accept a reasonable offer, 1.a) or 1.b) above, and to sign a purchase and sale agreement based on the vote of the congregation at this Special Meeting of Members, May 18, 2025.
- 3. To endeavor to find a new home for the organ if the buyer of the property is not interested in having the organ included in the sale.
