IMPORTANT NOTICE from the Oversight Committee:

The Oversight Committee has called a **Special Congregational Meeting for Sunday**, **Dec. 7**, to ask the congregation to vote on the following recommendation:

The Oversight Committee of Old South Congregational Church, United Church of Christ, Hallowell, Maine, recommends a decommissioning of the sanctuary building on or before December 31, 2025, with worship and all church activities permanently moved to the Parish House. The decommissioning would involve reduction of utilities in the sanctuary building to a bare minimum, to keep the pipes from freezing and to maintain the organ (which will remain at least until the spring).

In anticipation of questions and concerns regarding this recommendation, the Oversight Committee invites you to attend a **Zoom gathering on Monday, December 1, at 7:00pm (use the Bible Bunch/Meetings link in the News&Notes)**. Members of Oversight will be present to answer questions and to discuss further the recommendation.
